Your Commitment

- Show up on time or early for your shift
- Report to the Volunteer/Performer Check-in Tent (on the south side of 4th street, just west of the Vern Burton.)
- Orient yourself with the ticket sales office, the restrooms, and where each stage is.
- Proceed to your assigned position and stay there for the duration of your shift. Arrange quick breaks with other servers or your supervisor.

What your role entails

- YOU MUST HAVE A VALID WASHINGTON STATE **MAST** PERMIT!
- Pouring wine and serving beer from kegs:
 - Fill cups appropriately (5oz pours for wine, full 16oz cups for beer)
 - Charge ALL patrons correctly. JFFA is a non-profit organization and depends on beverage sales to have successful events.
 - Use the register and credit card machines correctly and efficiently
 - All tips stay with JFFA
- Follow all Washington State serving laws.
 - No over service
 - ID everyone under 35 years old
- Be flexible and helpful. We work as a team to provide the best possible experience for everyone.

Dress comfortably. You will be on your feet for the entirety of your shift.

Our Commitment

We will provide:

- Square card processing systems, change, all pouring supplies
- Map of the Venue and additional schedules
- All required Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board signage

In exchange for fulfilling your commitment, the Juan de Fuca Foundation for the Arts will provide you with a one-day pass for the festival. This can be picked up at the Volunteer Check-in Tent.
